

LMC Signage Working Group

Overview Principles:

- Use TTOR's trail marking system:
 - Mark trail intersections with numbers keyed to a map
 - Name main trails only
- For signs use TTOR graphic standards and materials
 - Waterproof DiBond laminated signs
 - Dark green background with white lettering
- Bicycle-free trails will be marked with the No-Bike Graphic graphic (bicycle with diagonal slash)
- For sign implementation use Makepeace Digital Imaging (TTOR vendor)
- For map creation use MapWorks (Rock Meadow vendor)

Note: To make sure that signage is clear, final design and composition of signs will be coordinated with placement and determined on site.

Trail Junction	#1	- <1> - Pine Allee, No-Bike Graphic, (Arrow as needed) - Meadow Trail, (Arrow as needed)
Trail Access Point	Western Greenway entrance from Concord Ave. and Habitat	- No-Bike Graphic (on Pine Allee) Also: one of Tom's free standing rules signs

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Trail Access Point	#2 (Iron Gate on Concord Ave.)	- <2> - No-Bike Graphic (on Pine Allee) Also: one of Tom's free standing rules signs
Trail Junction	#3 (Near Concord Ave. Official Entry Point, Rules posted in nearby Concord Ave. Kiosk 2)	- <3> - Pine Allee, No-Bike Graphic, (Arrow as needed) - To Kiosk, (Arrow as needed)
Trail Junction	#4 (Entry from Cell Tower, Rules posted in nearby Concord Ave. Kiosk 2)	- <4> - Pine Allee, No-Bike Graphic, (Arrow as needed) - To Kiosk, (Arrow as needed)
Trail Junction	#5	- <5>
Trail Access Point	Unofficial Entry from Belmont Day School Parking Lot (not marked on map)	Relocate one of Tom's free standing rules signs (emphasize Dogs Must Be Leashed)
Trail Junction	#6	- <6> - Cemetery, (Arrow as needed) - Red Maple to Lone Tree Hill, (Arrow as needed) - Coal Road, (Arrow as needed)
Trail Junction	#7	- <7>
Trail Junction	#8	- <8> - No-Bike Graphic (between #8 and #9)
Trail Junction	#9	- <9> - No-Bike Graphic (between #8 and #9)
Trail Junction	#10	- <10>

Trail Junction	#13 (4 way intersection)	- <13> - No-Bike Graphic (towards Lone Tree)

Trail Junction and Trail Access Point	#14 Woodlands Access (4 way intersection)	- <14> - No-Bike Graphic (up hill to Lone Tree) Also: one of Tom's free standing rules signs
Trail Junction	#15	- <15> - No-Bike Graphic (up hill)
Trail Junction	#16 (4 way intersection)	- <16> - No-Bike Graphic (perhaps both ways)
