2012 Pet License

If your dog or cat was licensed in Belmont during 2011 and is no longer living in Belmont (moved or deceased), please inform the Town Clerk's Office at 617-993-2600.

According to Belmont By-Law 20.11 all dogs and cats age four months and older require a license which is valid from January 1st through December 31st. Licensing must be completed no later than March 15th. The license fee is increased effective April 16th, except for new pets.

Annual Pet License Fees

If pet is licensed or application is postmarked on or before April 15, 2012:

- o Neutered/Spayed: \$12.00 per pet; \$9.00 if owner is 60 years of age or older
- o Unaltered: \$37.00 per pet; \$34.00 if owner is 60 years of age or older.

If pet is licensed or application is postmarked on or after April 16, 2012:

- o Neutered/Spayed: \$24.00 per pet; \$18.00 if owner is 60 years of age or older
- o Unaltered: \$49.00 per pet; \$43.00 if owner is 60 years of age or older.

To apply on-line, please go to www.belmont-ma.gov, select Online Bill Payment and follow directions.

At this time on-line licensing is available only for renewals of pets with valid rabies vaccine on file.

To apply by mail, please send us:

- o Your completed application
- o Vaccination documentation (showing current rabies vaccine expiration date)
- o Check (payable to Town of Belmont)
- o A stamped, self-addressed envelope in which we will mail a receipt and license tag to you.

To apply in person:

- o Please supply your pet's vaccination documentation (current rabies vaccine expiration date)
- o Provide payment (cash or check, payable to Town of Belmont)
- o The Town Clerk's office is open Monday through Friday 8:00am - 4:00pm.
- o We love cats and dogs, but please remember that they are not permitted in public buildings.

For your convenience, this application is also posted on the Town Clerk's page of the Town website (www.belmont-ma.gov). Please call us with any questions at 617-993-2600. Failure to license pets will result in a \$25.00 fine and the requirement to license. **Thank you for your cooperation to ensure that all domestic animals have timely rabies vaccinations.**
