Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Belmont, qualified as the law requires to vote in elections and Town Affairs, to meet at their respective polling places in said Town on MONDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2005, between seven o'clock in the forenoon and eight o'clock in the evening of said day to give their votes on the following question:

"Shall the Town of Belmont be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Proposition 2-1/2, so called, the amount required to pay for the bonds issued in order to design and construct a municipal senior center, including land acquisition costs, the cost of original equipment and furnishings, and all other costs incidental and related thereto?"
